## 文法專題:倒裝句(Inverted Sentences)

**KEY POINT 1** 

否定副詞置於句首+倒裝結構

- 1. Never have I seen a more careless boy than John.
- 2. Nowhere else can travelers buy so much beauty for so little money.
- 3. By no means shall I share my room John.
- 4. Scarcely did I go to that restaurant.
- 5. Not until you lose your health will you know the value of it.
- 6. But not in vain had he grown old; more numerous than the white hairs on her head were the wise thoughts in his mind.
- 7. Little did we dream that we should ever see each other again.
- 8. Not a bit am I afraid.  $\rightarrow$  Not a bit am I afraid of. (X)
- 9. Not merely does he have a first-class brain, but he is a hard worker.
- 10. Seldom have I seen such a crowd of people coming out for a parade.
- 11. Barely does he have enough money to live on.
- 12. Under no circumstances (=In no way = By no means= Not on any account = On no account) should you be allowed to stay up late, since you are now in poor health.

#### **KEY POINT 2**

(1) Only + O/ ADV PHRASE/ ADV CLAUSE + 倒裝結構

(2) Only + S + 不倒裝結構

- 1. Only with the full agreement of everyone can we stop the plan.
- 2. Only then did he realize his mistakes.
- 3. Only when he is here does he speak English.
- 4. Only in winter will this kind of chocolates be on the market.
- 5. Only by working hard can you succeed in doing everything.

**Inverted Sentences** 

- 6. Only when one loses freedom does one know its value.
- 7. Only a fundamental change in attitude toward work can bring rapid development.
- 8. Only Jack can help me out.

### KEY POINT 3

There / Here / Likewise / Such / Thus / Well / Often / So ... + 倒裝結構

- 1. Such is the way he overcomes difficulties.
- 2. So surprised was he that he uttered nothing when he saw me.
- 3. Many a time have I told you not to make the same mistake again.
- 4. Often have I heard it said that he is trustworthy.
- 5. Twice within my lifetime have world wars taken place.
- 6. As men sow, so will they also reap.
- 7. So hot was it that I took off my jacket.

### **KEY POINT 4**

當補語用的形容詞或分詞置於句首 + 倒裝結構

- 1. Happy will be the man who wins her heart.
- 2. Getting out of the carriage was her sister Rosaline.
- 3. Poor is the man who doesn't read, and empty is his life.
- 4. Blood-red became the sun.
- 5. Gone are the days when my heart was young and gay.
- 6. Enclosed is an invoice confirming the transaction.
- 7. Blessed are the pure in heart.
- 8. Fortunate is the man who know the value of health.

KEY POINT 5 (讓步)

 $N / ADJ / ADV / V + as + S + V \dots, S + V$ 

- 1. Fool as he is, he will not do such a silly thing.
- 2. Brave as he is, he trembles at the sight of a snake.
- 3. Much as I enjoyed the food, I did not like the service.
- 4. Try as hard as you may, you won't be able to finish it in one week.

KEY POINT 6 (原因)

Ving /  $P.P + as + S + V \dots, S + V$ 

- Standing as it does on the top of the hill, our school has a full view of the city.
  =Because our school stands on the top of the hill, ...
- 2. Living as I do in the suburbs, I have few visitors.=Because I live in the suburbs, ...
